After our last conversation regarding unethical legal practices by Judge William Henry, I spoke with the House of Representatives Judiciary Committee. The Committee then provided information to me that I trust you will find useful.

Regarding your charge of unethical behavior on the part of Judge Henry, the law in that area is well settled: you may file a complaint with the Judicial Conduct Board. They have a team of investigators that look into allegations of unethical behavior on the part of judges.

You may reach the board by calling 717-234-7911 or by writing to the Judicial Conduct Board, 225 Market Street, Harrisburg, PA 17101.

In your letter, you wrote that you were considering filing an Impeachment Petition against Judge Henry. Any citizen may write to the chief clerk of the House of Representatives about impeachment. The chief clerk is Ted Mazia. His address is Main Capitol Building, House of Representatives, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

Regarding your Impeachment Petition against Judge Carpenter, as you know, the Chief Clerk has forwarded your petition to the House Judiciary Committee for review. Committee staff informs me that this matter is under review. I am certain that following their review, appropriate action will be taken.
