Dear Sir or Madam,

On or about January 5, 2006, I filed a complaint with this office regarding egregious civil rights violations and widespread judicial corruption within the Blair County Court system. Further the extensive documentation I provided your office described and evidenced a gruesome environment that my daughter Stephanie J. Kearns was placed in. I had hoped that an immediate investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation would have rescued and released my daughter from a condition of Bedlam and false imprisonment before her mind and body was totally destroyed.

As per the advice of the state attorney general's office (letter attached) I filed a complaint with the new Blair County District Attorney, Richard Consiglio. I did this on August 12, 2006, and Mr. Consiglio refuses to respond to my complaint. This comes as no real surprise to me since Mr. Consiglio was the original custody master in my case and was fully aware that transcripts were being altered to cover up Dr. Nancy Baker's wholesale psychological abuses of many dozens of children that the court referred to her office for counseling or evaluations.

In my attempts to break through the grid-lock of corruption in Blair County, I re-submit this complaint to your office for action.

To bring you up to speed I enclosed my August 12, 2006, and December 27, 2006, complaint letters that I sent to District Attorney Consiglio.
