Dear Representative Thomas R. Caltagirone,

On or about February 13, 2007, I re-filed with the House of Representatives two Impeachment Petitions against Judge Hiram Carpenter of Blair County, Pennsylvania, and Judge William Henry of Jefferson County, Pennsylvania. Just a brief examination of those petitions by the judiciary committee will reveal and evidence a pattern of judicial abuse that includes but is not limited to criminal misconduct of office, violations of oath of office, and violations of Judicial Canons. In short, the criminal and predatory conduct of these two judges is reminiscent to a judicial process trumped up in a banana republic.

Additionally, the House Judiciary Committee was served a document of Second Notice of Impeachment (attachment enclosed) that requested a response from the judiciary committee within 30 days of receipt as to why this matter has been allowed to lie in repose for the past five years. Since, ninety days have passed without so much of an acknowledgment from your committee, or a single house member. At this point in time I think it is safe to presume that no preliminary inquiry was ever initiated into the crimes of these two corrupt judges. Further it appears that it is the posture of the House Judiciary Committee to avoid and keep covered up this issue by any means necessary, even it has to ignore and violate the Constitutions of the United States and Pennsylvania. Could it be the entire Pennsylvania legislature is as corrupt as the judicial system?

While my constitutional options of seeking redress of grievances have fallen on deaf ears, I would be very much interested in your opinions, or for that matter, the opinions of any house member as to exactly what should be done to bring these criminals to justice? What can you do as a citizen's representative in providing justice for me and my daughter? Have you notified the Attorney General's Office of these crimes? Have you requested any law enforcement agency to conduct a criminal investigation? Would you recommend that I file a Civil Rights lawsuit in Federal Court? Should I file a Writ Of Mandamus lawsuit in Commonwealth Court hoping to force the legislature to perform its constitutional duties? Perhaps this would generate some statewide media coverage. After five years of run-around I must admit that I am getting a whole lot frustrated that my government would protect these black robed criminals at the expense of destroying my daughter. I anticipate your response.
