On February 22, 2002 and July 1, 2003, respectively, I sent a petition for impeachment and affidavit in support of impeachment of each of the above-listed judges (please see attached). As of the date of this letter, I have not received any response whatsoever to these two (2) petitions for impeachment. As a sovereign American citizen and citizen of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and as one who has been savagely victimized due to the perpetration of judicial fraud via civil rights violations of due process and equal rights, I am once again renewing my petitions for impeachment in this Second Notice of Petitions for the Impeachment.

As members of the Pennsylvania House Judiciary Committee, you have a primary material and legal obligation to honor your Oath of Office, as mandated by the federal and state constitutions. As a sovereign American citizen and citizen of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, I have an inalienable right, protected by the federal and state constitutions to redress of grievance. I respectfully wish to draw your attention to the Table of Authorities listed below in this document, in support of these doctrines.

## **NOTICE**

This Second Notice of Petitions for Impeachment is lawful notification and is sent pursuant to the federal Constitution, specifically, the Bill of Rights, in particular, the First, Fifth, Ninth and Tenth Amendments and the Fourteenth Amendment and pursuant to your Oaths of Office and requires your written response to me within thirty (30) days. Notification of legal responsibility is “the first essential of due process of law” *Connally v General Construction Co.*, 269 U.S. 385, 391. See also *U.S. v Tweel*, 550 F.2d.297 “Silence can only be equated with fraud where there is a legal or moral duty to speak or when an inquiry left unanswered would be intentionally misleading.”

This Second Notice of Petitions for Impeachment is lawful notification and is also sent pursuant to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, specifically the Declaration of Rights, in particular, Article I Sections 1, 2, 7, 9, 11, 17, 20, 24, 25 and 26 and Article II Section 11, 13 and 15 and Article V Section 17 (b) and Article VI Sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7.

If you disagree with anything in this document, then rebut that with which you disagree, in writing, with particularity, to me, within thirty (30) days of this document’s date, and support your disagreement with fact, evidence and constitutionally based law and/or case law. Your failure to respond, as stipulated, is your agreement with and admission to the fact that everything in this document is true, correct, legal, lawful, and your irrevocable admission attesting to this, fully binding upon you in any court in America, without your protest or objection.


