Sandy Fluke told me at the end of the visit that she can not make these decisions, that would be up to Mears. Fluke suggested that I contact you to check with Mears to see if the enclosed note would be appropriate. Please advise me on Mears decision before Monday. Sorry to be a pain, but this is important for Stephanie to know that her extended family remembers and cares about her. I forgot to mention this to you earlier, but I wasn't allowed to give Stephanie a birthday card because it had a personal message. Also, Stephanie was not allowed to receive any cards from any other members of my side of the family. This kind of isolation and *treatment is not only bull crap, it is abusive to all involved.*

Also, I have been told by Sandy Fluke that these supervised visits have been scheduled on through the month of September. Perhaps when your talking to Mears you can give her a little push to get something moving to correct the mess she helped create. If she intends to avoid this issue longer than September, I think we had better file something alternatively. Thanks again.
